## CLASSES

1. 40cm (ORS or JO\*)
2. 50cm (ORS or JO\*)
3. 60cm (ORS or JO\*)
4. 70cm (ORS or JO\*)
5. Rescue Relay (40/50)
6. Rescue Relay (60/70)
7. TYOL (40/50)
8. TYOL (60/70)
9. 6 Bar (max first round 60cm)

ORS = One Round Stakes - Article 238 2.1 JO = Jump Off (one round with a jump off) – Article 238 2.2 TYOL = Take Your Own Line - Article 271	*The type of class will be dependent on number of entries and advised when the draw is issued
The Rescue Relay is a pairs event. Both riders must enter the class and advise us on the day who their partner is.	Horses are not permitted to be entered in both height options for the same events. EG: you cannot enter both Rescue Relay or both TYOL classes.

## FEES

Entry Fees (all classes) \$5

Day membership – reduced to just \$5 (normally \$30)



## **MAXIMUM CLASSES**

Horses may be entered in a maximum of 3 classes.

## **DRESS**

Riders may wear either standard competition attire or casual attire. Polo shirts and breeches/jodhpurs of any colour are permitted.

Singlets and sleeveless shirts are not permitted.

Riders must be wearing an EA compliant and tagged helmet at all times when mounted (this applies to any part of the grounds, including the warm up area)

All other tack and equipment must be in accordance with EA rules.

## **RULES**

All events are run under FEI, EA or DSJC rules. It is the sole responsibility of competitors to ensure they are aware of all relevant rules.
