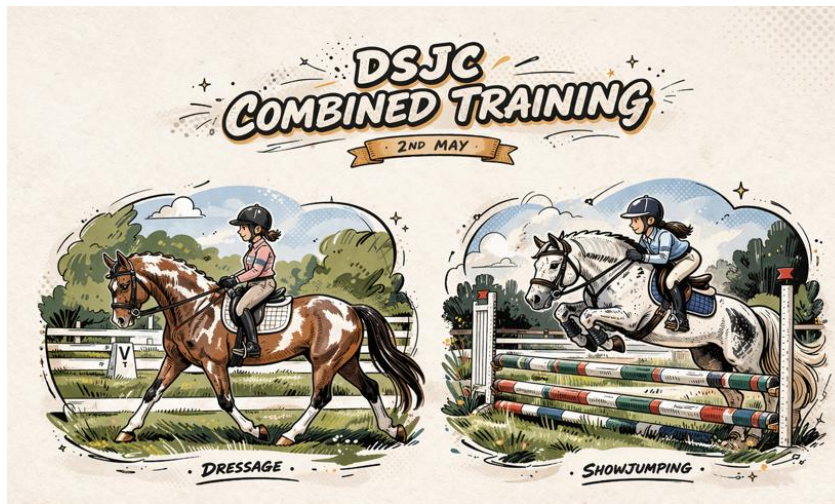

Class	CT Level	Dressage Test	Jumping Height	**NOTE**
1	P50	Prelim 1.1	50cm	<p>If you enter 2 x CT classes that have either the same dressage level, or the same jumping height you will only do that test/height once.</p> <p>Example: If you enter P60 and N60 – you will only ride the 60cm jumping round once, and your score will count for both the P60 and the N60.</p>
2	P60	Prelim 1.2	60cm	
3	P70	Prelim 1.1	70cm	
4	P80	Prelim 1.2	80cm	
5	P90	Prelim 1.3	90cm	
6	N60	Novice 2.1	60cm	
7	N70	Novice 2.2	70cm	
8	N80	Novice 2.2	80cm	
9	N90	Novice 2.3	90cm	

Fees: \$20 per class. Maximum 2 classes per horse.

How Does Combined Training work?

Combined Training is derived from Eventing, but it excludes the cross country phase. Horse & rider combinations are scored on penalties in the dressage phase, and this is then added to any penalties from the corresponding jumping phase. The combination with the lowest penalties is the winner.

The jumping phase is a 1 round class with a time allowed. Completing the course in less than the time allowed is not rewarded, but exceeding the time allowed, Athletes are penalised with 0.4 penalties per commenced second. The jumping phase is conducted under Table A, and all other usual jumping rules apply.

Event Rules

Dress and gear requirements are as per the EA Dressage or Jumping rules, however here are some quick rules to note:

- Horses may only be entered in a maximum of 2 CT classes
- Elimination in one phase results in elimination from the overall class
- Whip length:
 - Jumping phase: 75cm
 - Dressage phase: Horses 1.2m, ponies 1.0m
- Horses in the dressage phase must have a noseband on
- Horses must not have any leg boots on during the dressage phase
- Riders in the dressage phase must be wearing gloves
- Riders may compete in both phases in either a dressage or jumping saddle
