CLASSES

1. 40cm (Cross rails only) (Special Two Phase)
2. 50cm (Special Two Phase)
3. 60cm (Special Two Phase)
4. 70cm (Special Two Phase)
5. Rescue Relay (40/50)
6. Rescue Relay (60/70)
7. Ride and Run (60)
8. 6 Bar (max first round 60cm)



Special Two Phase – Article 222.2

Class run with 2 phases – the finish line for phase 1 is the same as the start line for phase 2. All riders do both phases (unless eliminated). Phase 2 is against the clock. Placing is determined by an aggregate of penalties in both phases and if necessary, the time in the second phase.

Rescue Relay – This is a pairs event. Both riders must enter the class and advise us on the day who their partner is. Exact rules will be explained on the day. Horses are not permitted to be entered in both height options for this class.

Ride and Run – this is a novelty event and each rider will require a 'runner'. Only the rider has to enter the class. The 'runner' will be required to run a short course after the rider has completed their round. The rider's time and the runner's time will be combined to determine placings.

FEES

Entry Fee - \$10 per horse (for up to 3 classes)

Day membership: **Free**

Course levy: **Free**



All riders must select either set up (Friday evening) or pack up. This is compulsory.

MAXIMUM CLASSES

Horses may be entered in a maximum of 3 classes.

DRESS

Riders may wear either standard competition attire or casual attire. Polo shirts and breeches/jodhpurs of any colour are permitted.

Singlets and sleeveless shirts are not permitted.

Riders must be wearing an EA compliant and tagged helmet at all times when mounted (this applies to any part of the grounds, including the warm up area)

All other tack and equipment must be in accordance with EA rules.

RULES

All events are run under FEI, EA or DSJC rules. It is the sole responsibility of competitors to ensure they are aware of all relevant rules.
