Membership

All riders must be full financial members of DSJC. Day membership is not available.

TRNT Off The Track Series

Off the track Thoroughbreds, registered with TRNT will be eligible for the OTT Series. If you have an OTTB, please make sure you have entered your details via Global Entries (it is listed as a separate “event”).



Finch Farm Clear Round Series

The 2026 Clear Round Series, sponsored by Finch Farm is for all riders, with two categories:

- Under 25 yrs and
- 25 +

Age is as at 1 January 2026. Riders are eligible for points for clear rounds, with the overall winner in each category announced at the end of year presentations.

Maximum Classes

Horses may be entered in a maximum of 2 classes. Horses that are entered in a class for which it is not eligible to compete in will automatically be listed as HC on the draw. All HC entries will ride first on the draw.

Dress / Helmets

Dress regulations are in accordance with the EA Jumping rules. In addition to these rules, the following dress regulations will apply for this event:

- Jackets are optional
- Shirts must not be sleeveless, long sleeved shirts must have sleeves rolled down and buttoned
- Shirts must be tucked in, and collars done up
- Shirts must have a ratcatcher style collar (zip up is fine) or a traditional business style collar
- Business style collars must also have a tie
- Polo shirts are not accepted (this includes long sleeved fishing/sun style shirts)
- Jodhpurs/breeches must be white, beige, light beige or other similar light colour
- Coloured jodhpurs/breeches are not permitted (ie black, blue, purple, patterned etc)
- Riders must be wearing an EA compliant and tagged helmet at all times when mounted. Helmet tagging is not offered at the event.

Rules:

All DSJC events are run under FEI, EA or DSJC rules where relevant. It is the sole responsibility of competitors to ensure they are aware of all relevant rules.
